CALL TO ORDER The meeting was called to order by Mayor Pat Hewitt.

**CHICKENS
IN CITY**

APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE #1055-12-15B	Moved by Innes, seconded by Rogers, to approve an ordinance to pay the bills for the month of December. Voting Aye: ALL. Opposed: NONE. Statutory majority having voted for this ordinance; the city clerk assigned it ordinance #1055-12-15B.
	Driggs returned to the meeting.
COURT FEES	Chance reported the education fee the State of Kansas assesses on each municipal court fine is going up from \$.50 to \$1.00.
2016 CMB SHOPKO	Moved by James, seconded by Speake, to approve the 2016 Cereal Malt Beverage license for Shopko. Voting Aye: ALL. Opposed: NONE.
PUBLIC WORKS	Driggs reported on work being done by the Public Works Department.
QUANZ RESERVOIR	Discussion was held concerning the rehabilitation project for the Quanz Reservoir. Work will include a new floor and top as well as updates to the pumps. The Public Works Department will install valves to allow the east wells to be used while the construction work is being completed. The cost is estimated to be under \$600,000. The project could be ready for construction in the fall of 2016.
AUTO READ METERS	Discussion was held concerning the updating of water meters to allow for automated reading as well as being able to turn meters on and off from the office. Driggs will provide cost justifications for the change to the Council. A presentation of the meter information will be scheduled at a future meeting.
FINANCE	Discussion was held concerning financing of the Quanz Reservoir and auto read meter project with the revolving loan fund. Projects requesting loan funds must be submitted to the KDHE in May.
DANGEROUS STRUCTURES	Driggs reported work on the dangerous structure at 262 Walnut has not begun. Work on the structures at 176 1 st Street and 545 F Street has not been completed. The Council will review the resolutions sent to owners at the next meeting.
	Driggs will be assisting the City of Logan with dangerous structures on his own time.
CINTAS	Cintas has not responded to the letter sent by the city attorney. It was the consensus of the Council that Driggs and the Mayor deliver the uniform shirts to Cintas in Dodge City.
PLANNING	Driggs will ask the Planning Commission to review the parking ordinance again.
WATER	Stites thanked the Public Works Department for their work to fix the water leak on New Year's Eve.
KRWA	Mayor Hewitt and Council member Stites will consider attending the Kansas Rural Water Conference in March along with public works employees.

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 9

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 14-201 AND K.S.A. 14-204, RELATING TO THE ELECTION OF OFFICERS, THEIR TERMS OF OFFICE, TRANSITIONS TO NOVEMBER ELECTIONS, THE APPOINTMENT OF OFFICERS, AND NOMINATION PETITIONS; AND, PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE AND ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS ON THE SAME SUBJECT AND REPEALING CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 2.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, by the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Kansas Constitution hereby elects to and does exempt itself and make inapplicable to it the provisions of K.S.A. 14-201 and K.S.A. 14-204, that apply to this city, but are parts of enactments which do not apply uniformly to all cities.

SECTION 2. (a) The governing body shall consist of a mayor and 6 council members to be elected to terms as set forth herein. The city treasurer shall be elected to terms as set forth herein. The mayor and council members, and city treasurer shall be residents and qualified electors of the city of Phillipsburg, Kansas.

(b) The governing body of the city may, by ordinance, divide the city into wards and precincts, establish the boundaries thereof, and number the same. No ordinance redefining wards and precincts shall become effective less than 30 days prior to the next regular city election.

SECTION 3. The governing body positions and city treasurer with terms expiring in April 2017, shall expire on the second Monday in January of 2018, when the city officials elected in the November 2017 general election take office. Those governing body positions with terms expiring in April 2019, shall expire on the second Monday in January of 2020, when the city officials elected in the November 2019 general election take office.

SECTION 4. A general election of city officers shall take place on the Tuesday succeeding the first Monday in November 2017. Succeeding elections will be held every two years for all such governing body positions whose terms have expired. One council member from each ward shall be elected at one election, and the other council member from that ward shall be elected at the succeeding election. The council members shall have four year terms. The Mayor and city treasurer shall have a two year term.

SECTION 5. The mayor shall appoint, by and with the consent of the council, a municipal judge of the municipal court, a chief of police, city clerk, city attorney, and any other officers deemed necessary. Any officers appointed and confirmed shall hold an initial term of office of not to exceed one year and until their successors are appointed and qualified. Any officers who are reappointed shall hold their offices for a term of one year and until their successors are appointed and qualified. The council shall by ordinance specify the duties and compensation of the office holders, and by ordinance may abolish any office created by the council whenever deemed expedient.

SECTION 6. In accordance with K.S.A. 25-205, and amendments thereto, any person may become a candidate for city office elected at large by having had filed on their behalf, a nomination petition or a declaration of candidacy, accompanied by any fee required by law. The nomination petition must be signed by 25 electors eligible to vote for such candidate or by the number of electors equal to 10 percent of the ballots cast and counted at the last general city election whichever is the lesser.

SECTION 7. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official newspaper.

SECTION 8. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect 61 days after the final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filled, requiring a referendum to be held on the ordinance as provided by Article 12, Section 5, Subsection (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this Charter Ordinance shall become effective upon approval by the majority of the electors voting thereon. That upon this Charter Ordinance No. 9 becoming effective simultaneously thereto Charter Ordinance No. 2 shall be repealed.

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 10

A CHARTER ORDINANCE EXEMPTING THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF L. 2015, CHAPTER 88, SECTION 71, RELATING TO THE FILING OF GOVERNING BODY VACANCIES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, by virtue of the power vested in it by Article 12, Section 5 of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, hereby elects and does exempt itself and make inapplicable to it L. 2015, Chapter 88, Section 71, relating to the filing of governing body vacancies, which enactment applies to this city, but does not apply uniformly to all cities.

SECTION 2. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

SECTION 3. This Charter Ordinance shall take effect 61 days after final publication unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the Charter Ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5, Subsection (c)(3) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, in which case this Charter Ordinance shall become effective if approved by the majority of the electors thereon.

PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL THE 18th DAY OF JANUARY, 2016, WITH NOT LESS THAN 2/3RDS OF THE ELECTED MEMBERS VOTING IN FAVOR THEREOF.
