MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

NOW, on this 21st day of September, 2009, the City of Phillipsburg, by and through its duly elected governing body, hereinafter referred to as "City", and the Heritage of Perpetual Endowment (HOPE) Foundation, hereinafter referred to as "Foundation" do hereby enter into the following MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING.

Property to be Transferred: Upon the Foundation meeting the following conditions specifically set forth below, the City does hereby pledge to transfer all titles, interest and ownership in real property commonly known as "the community building" more specifically described as:

Lots One(1), Two(2), Three(3), Four(4), Five(5), Six(6), Seven(7), Eight(8), Twenty-five (25) and the West Sixteen (16) feet of Lot Twenty-four (24), all in Block Six (6), Range Five (5) in the original Town of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas.

Conditions of transfer: Before the above described property will be transferred from the City to the Foundation, the following conditions must be met by the Foundation:

- a. The period of the City's commitment shall be in effect until the terms/conditions of the Memorandum of Understanding is executed by authorized representatives of each party.
- b. During the time this Memorandum of Understanding is in effect, the Foundation will establish a permanent endowment in an amount not less than Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) for the sole purpose of maintaining, preserving, restoring, and day to day expenses of ownership of the subject property.
- c. During the time this Memorandum of Understanding is in effect, the Foundation will be allowed to seek grant funding for renovations, preservation, restoration, and repairs on behalf of the subject property.

Control, Management of Subject Property: During the term of this Memorandum of Understanding, the Foundation shall assume the day to day operations of the subject property, including but not limited to, scheduling of activities, events and meetings of organizations in subject property, scheduling of maintenance and all other day to day functions necessary to continue operation of the property. By resolution, the City will grant Tammy D. Merklein, President of HOPE Foundation, the authority to assume the day to day operations as described above.

Director's and Employee(s)' Salary: The salary for the director or any other employee of the Foundation employed to help in the operation of the subject property shall be paid by the Foundation and shall come from funds outside of the permanent endowment subject to this agreement.

Right to Extend/Cancel/(modify):

- a. During the period of the City's commitment to this Memorandum of Understanding, the city will have the option to review or modify contract to accommodate the Foundations ability to seek grant funding as needed for acquisition of subject property.

Dissolution of Foundation: If during the period of this Memorandum of Understanding, the Foundation should dissolve, or otherwise cease to exist, then this Agreement shall terminate and any funds in the permanent endowment described above shall be given to an organization with I.R.S. 501(c)(3) status of the City's choosing, designated to the community building. In the event that after the transfer of title to the Foundation, the Foundation should dissolve, cease to exist, or would elect to sell the property, the City has first option to purchase for \$1.00, due to the City having ownership of this property prior to this agreement, and with the same understanding that any funds in the permanent endowment shall be given to an organization with I.R.S. 501 (c)(3) status of the City's choosing, designated to the community building.

Maintenance Costs of Subject Property: During the period of the Memorandum of Understanding, the City shall continue to pay all maintenance costs, utilities, upkeep and insurance on the subject property. Upon transfer of title to the Foundation, the Foundation agrees to assume all maintenance costs, utilities, upkeep, insurance and taxes, if applicable. The Foundation further agrees that during the period of Memorandum of Understanding and after transfer of title to the Foundation, the Foundation will keep the property clean, sanitary and maintained to a state of condition no less than current condition at the time of signing of this agreement.

Early Completion of the Memorandum:

Once the Foundation fully funds the permanent endowment described above, the City shall have ninety (90) days from the verification of the endowment to provide the Foundation with clear title to the subject property. Upon transfer of title the Foundation shall be responsible for all maintenance costs, utilities, upkeep and insurance and applicable taxes of the subject property.

Completion of Agreement:

Upon completion of the terms/conditions of the Memorandum of Understanding, the City shall have ninety (90) days from the verification of the endowment to provide the Foundation with clear title to the subject property. Upon transfer of title the Foundation shall be responsible for all maintenance costs, utilities, upkeep and insurance and applicable taxes of the subject property.

Termination of all Previous Contracts or Agreements: By executing this Memorandum of Understanding, the City hereby terminates all prior agreements it has made with other entities regarding the use of the subject property with the exception of a certain rental agreement between the City and Kansas Department of Revenue, Division of Motor Vehicles. During the term of this Memorandum of Understanding, the City shall be entitled to all rents received from said rental agreement as well as all gymnasium rental fees.

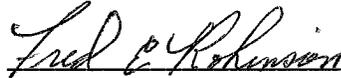
Renovation and Repairs:

During the term of the Memorandum of Understanding the Foundation will seek funding to make renovations and/or repairs to the subject property. All such renovations and repairs will be approved by the City in writing, which includes provisions for payment of such renovations and/or repairs.

Entire Agreement: This Memorandum of Understanding encompasses the full agreement of the parties and oral agreements made before the execution of this agreement are merged within this document. It is agreed by both parties that any changes or modifications to this Agreement shall be made in writing and signed by both parties by a person with authority to do so.

Applicable Law: This Memorandum of Understanding was created in Kansas, under Kansas law and Kansas law shall apply to its interpretation and construction and enforcement.
