The Phillipsburg City Council met in regular session on February 1, 2016, 6:00 P.M., at the Phillipsburg City Office, 945 Second Street.

- CALL TO ORDER** The meeting was called to order by Mayor Patrick Hewitt.
- ATTENDANCE** **PRESENT:** Council members Mike James; Lynette Voorhees; Rod Innes; Travis Stites; Pete Rogers.
- ABSENT:** Council member Donna Speake.
- ALSO PRESENT:** Scott Sage, City Attorney; Tim Driggs, Public Works Supervisor; Tad Felts, reporter KKAN/KQMA; Shawn Ellenberger; Dan & Mary Price; Scott & Tammy Merklein; Brett Biggs; Amy Stephens; Brenda Chance, City Clerk.
- NEEDS ASSESSMENT** Gary Brinker, representing the Docking Institute of Fort Hays State University, joined the meeting by Skype. Brinker provided information to the Council concerning the Docking Institute's ability to complete a community needs survey. The cost of the survey would be \$4,250 with the city providing the phone number database and completing the survey in the next week. Discussion followed.
- Brinker left the meeting at 6:26 p.m.
- Moved by Rogers, seconded by Voorhees, to use FHSU to do a phone survey at a cost not to exceed \$4,500 and authorize FHSU to utilize the city's phone number database. Voting Aye: James; Voorhees; Innes; Rogers. Opposed: Stites.
- COMMUNITY BUILDING** Amy Stephens and Tammy Merklein provided information to the Council concerning the HOPE Foundation and the operation of the community building. Discussion was held concerning the HOPE Foundation assisting the city concerning problems with broken windows. Discussion was also held concerning increasing the thermostat temperature for renters.
- Merkleins and Stephens left at 6:45 p.m.
- AIRPORT INS** Brett Biggs provided information to the Council concerning the insurance coverage at the airport. Moved by Innes, seconded by Rogers, to include hangar keepers insurance. Voting Aye: ALL. Opposed: NONE.
- MINUTES APPROVED** Moved by Voorhees, seconded by Stites, to approve the minutes of the January 18, 2016 meeting as written. Voting Aye: ALL. Opposed: NONE.
- APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE #1055-01-16B** Moved by Rogers, seconded by Innes, to approve an ordinance to pay the bills for the month of January. Voting Aye: ALL. Opposed: NONE. Statutory majority having voted for this ordinance; the city clerk assigned it ordinance #1055-01-16B.

BIKE ACROSS  
KANSAS Information was provided concerning the June visit of Bike across Kansas. Mayor Hewitt will serve on the Phillipsburg Chamber & Main Street committee to prepare for the visit.

OFFICE PRINTER Moved by Voorhees, seconded by Innes, to purchase a HPM605X printer for the office. Voting Aye: ALL. Opposed: NONE.

PHONE SYSTEM Chance invited the Council to attend a phone demonstration at the city office on Thursday at 1:30 presented by Nex-Tech.

PUBLIC WORKS Driggs reported on activities of the public works department. Trees are being trimmed along the highway right of ways.

AIRPORT The Airport Board recommended Olsson Engineering put together a proposal for designing an additional hangar taxiway for 2017 funding. The Airport Board is looking at being able to have space for additional hangars.

PLANNING The Planning Commission will be meeting with John Riggs to discuss the parking ordinances.

WASTEWATER Discussion was held concerning wastewater rates. Sample rates analysis will be provided for the following:  
35% increase in the minimum and the per 1,000 gallon charge  
35% increase in the minimum with no per 1,000 gallon charge change  
60% increase in the minimum with no per 1,000 gallon charge change  
75% increase in the minimum with no per 1,000 gallon charge change.

DANGEROUS  
STRUCTURES Discussion was held concerning the structures at 541 F, 176 1<sup>st</sup>, and 262 Walnut. Repair work has been started at the 541 F and 176 1<sup>st</sup> addresses. A bid to tear down the 262 Walnut structure will be obtained. The Phillips County Commissioners will be contacted concerning the landfill fee for the demolition waste.

COMMUNITY  
BUILDING The heat at the community building was discussed. Driggs will get prices for fans and also information concerning window replacement.

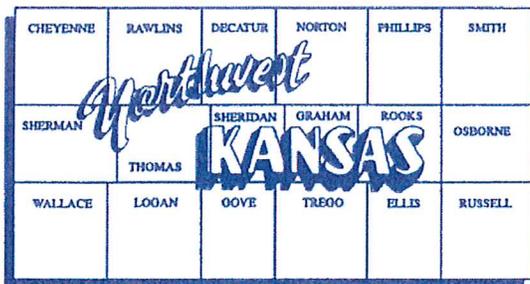

Dear City and County Government Leaders:

Northwest Kansas Planning & Development Commission (NWKP&DC) has proudly served the communities of Northwest Kansas for over the past 30+ years, bringing millions of dollars in grant funds to the area. If your community/county is considering making an application for 2017 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding, it would be our pleasure to assist with its preparation.

The 2017 CDBG competitive application deadlines have not yet been announced. We are expecting it to be similar to last year's 2016 deadlines:

- **Housing** **August 31**
- **Water and Sewer** **September 30**
- **Community Facilities** **November 2**

The updated deadlines will be disclosed at the 2017 CDBG Application workshop scheduled for April, 2016. If your community is interested in submitting a CDBG application, you are highly encouraged to attend this meeting. The Kansas Department of Commerce (KDOC) will mail communities fliers with details and information necessary to register for the workshop.

Prompt attention must be paid to not only these application deadlines, but to the information gathering timeline requirements enclosed (these dates reflect last year's deadlines which we anticipate to be similar). The preparation deadlines will ensure that everyone's efforts to complete the application are well organized, result in an application in the best format possible and it meets all CDBG criteria. All potential grant applicants need to start making plans now.

Application requirements that generally take considerable time include: low-to-moderate income surveys; defining the project's scope of work and target area of beneficiaries; land acquisition procedures; the pre-selection of professional services such as engineers, architects or housing inspectors; the preparation of preliminary reports and cost estimates; and firm commitments from other matching funding sources. Matching funds must be a minimum of 25% of the entire project cost, although greater matches increase odds of receiving an award.

By now your community should have received the CDBG newsletter dated February, 2016. Please pay particular attention to the On the Road 2016 information on page 1. At the noted hearing, KDOC will discuss and accept comments regarding proposed changes listed for existing programs, take consideration of perceived needed changes that are not listed to existing programs, and will explain any new funding opportunities. If you are interested in any of these programs, you are highly encouraged to participate in the hearing by conference call as noted.

It is imperative that all potential applicants get started with application preparation as soon as possible. If you have a proposed application, please contact Corina Cox or Justine Benoit at (785) 421-2151 no later than March 1<sup>st</sup> for Downtown Commercial Rehabilitation projects or May 1<sup>st</sup> for Housing/Water & Sewer/Community Facilities projects. If you have already discussed a potential application with staff, please give us a call or email ([nwkpdc@ruraltel.net](mailto:nwkpdc@ruraltel.net)) to confirm your plans and make sure you are on our list.

HIAC meetings are usually held on the 3 <sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of each month (March-July). Profile is due by 5:00 p.m. at least two weeks prior to the HIAC meeting. All meetings will be in Topeka except for June 16 <sup>th</sup> is in Hays.
<b>July 1, 2015</b>	Last eligible date to complete and submit the HAT <u>if attending a HIAC meeting</u> . HIAC is highly recommended, but not mandatory. 5 points will be deducted in rating if not attended.
<b>Immediately following HAT no later than July 1, 2015</b>	<b>Project identified</b> and eligibility confirmed with NWKP&DC staff. Distribute <b>pre-applications</b> and gauge <b>Contractor</b> interest. Begin <b>Request for Qualifications</b> procedure [i.e. Project Inspection Services, Risk Assessor, Architect)].
