The Phillipsburg City Council met in regular session on November 21, 2016, 6:00 P.M., at the Phillipsburg City Office, 945 Second Street.

- CALL TO ORDER The meeting was called to order by Mayor Patrick Hewitt.

- ALSO PRESENT: Scott Sage, City Attorney; Tim Driggs, Public Works Supervisor Jesse Rhea, reporter KKAN/KQMA; Kirby Ross, reporter Phillips County Review; Shawn Ellenberger; Brenda Chance, City Clerk.

- CHAMBER
NOMINATIONS The award nomination form for the annual Chamber of Commerce and Main Street banquet was provided to the Council.
- TITLE VI Discussion was held concerning the Title VI policy.
- AIRPORT It was the consensus of the Council to not purchase the airport hangar from Dustin Cheney.

- PUBLIC WORKS Driggs reported on activities of the public works department. Discussion was held concerning the public works master plan. Discussion was held concerning the need for roof repairs at the armory, brick street repair/replacement, and Highway 36 repairs. Driggs will be on vacation November 30 – December 3.
- GEOCORE
2nd & G ST Moved by Innes, seconded by James, to authorize the mayor to sign the agreement with Geocore for a monitoring well on G Street near the alley between 1st and 2nd streets. Voting Aye: ALL. Opposed: NONE.
- DISASTER FEMA officials will be meeting with Driggs and Chance November 22nd.
- AQUATIC
CENTER Discussion was held concerning repairs needed for the jets in the therapy pool at the seating section.
- VEHICLES It was the consensus of the Council to authorize the purchase of 2 vehicles for the public works department at a cost of no more than \$50,000.
- POLICY Discussion was held concerning the Councils duty to set policy for guidance and let supervisors make the decisions within the policy limits.
- JPPC Stites presented recommendations from the Joint Personnel Policy Committee (JPPC) concerning the employee recognition supper. JPPC recommended renting the Huck Boyd Center at a cost of \$90 and have Bon Appetit cater the meal for \$15 per plate with one entree or \$18 per plate with two entrée choices. A \$225 deposit for the meal will be required. It was the consensus of the Council to go with the \$18 per plate meal and approve the deposit be paid.
- The next JPPC meeting will be November 29th. Employees will be asked to vote for an employee to fill the vacancy on the committee prior to the next meeting.

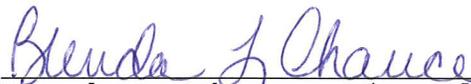

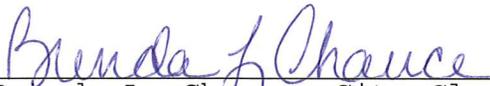

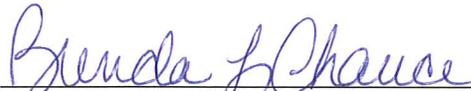

Limited English Proficiency (LEP) Plan Template

Introduction

On August 11, 2000, President Bill Clinton issued Executive Order 13166 "Improving access to Services for Persons with Limited English Proficiency," (65 FR 50121). The intent of this Executive Order is to improve access to federally conducted and federally assisted programs and activities for persons who are limited in their English proficiency. The purpose of developing an LEP plan, as a recipient of federal funds, is to identify the extent of LEP individuals in the region and identify ways that the transit agency can reduce and/or eliminate the barriers to LEP individuals. The starting point for developing this plan is to perform a four factor analysis to determine the individualized needs of the region. After these needs are identified, the transit agency should develop a language assistance plan addressing the mix of services that will be provided.

Four Factor Analysis

The total population for Phillips County KS is 5,296 of which 5,188 speak English only. Of this population 24 speak Spanish or Spanish Creole. 14 of the Spanish/Spanish Creole population speak English very well. 28 speak German with 25 of the German speaking population speaking English very well. The remaining 56 speak a variety of languages with 51 of those speaking English very well.

Identify the frequency in which LEP individuals come in contact with the service: **LEP individuals come in contact with our services less than 5% of the time.**

Identify the importance of the service to the LEP community: **Our LEP users are less than 1% of our ridership.**

Identify the resources available and the respective costs of these resources: **We have some community member that speak different languages. We would use this as our first resource which would be of no cost to us. We would also access the Language Department at FHSU for additional assistance if needed and they provide service to us at no cost. Online translation tools can be utilized also.**

Limited English Proficiency Plan

Identified LEP individuals

There are no specific population groups that meet the criteria of more than 5% with Limited English Proficiency.

Language Assistance Measures

We will use an interpreter to help us with communication and scheduling whenever possible. We would use online translation tools as well as contacting the Language Department at FHSU to assist with any language barriers we would encounter.

Training Staff

Employees be trained to use the above mentioned tools.

Providing Notice

LEP plan will be posted at the Phillipsburg City Office building. LEP plan will be provided to any person agency requesting a copy. The person of contact in regards to the LEP plan is the City Clerk and can be reached via phone at (785) 543-5234.

Monitoring and Updating LEP Plan

The City of Phillipsburg will update the plan according to the Title VI update schedule, which is every three (3) years. The plan will also be updated any time changes in the demographics of the service area are deemed significant in regards to LEP persons.

Title VI Complaint Procedure

Title VI Complaint Procedures

The following pertains only to Title VI complaints regarding the services of the City of Phillipsburg.

Title VI, 42 U.S.C. §2000d et seq., was enacted as part of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. At the heart of the regulation is the statement that:

No person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.

The City of Phillipsburg has in place a Title VI Complaint Procedure, which outlines a process for local disposition of Title VI complaints and is consistent with guidelines found in Chapter III of the Federal Transit Administration Circular 4702.1B, dated October 1, 2012. If you believe that the City of Phillipsburg's federally funded programs have discriminated your civil rights on the basis of race, color, or national origin you may file a written complaint by following the procedure outlined below:

1. Submission of Complaint.

Any person who feels that he or she, individually or as a member of any class of persons, on the basis of race, color, or national origin has been excluded from or denied the benefits of, or subjected to discrimination caused by the City of Phillipsburg, may file a written complaint with the Phillipsburg City Clerk. A complaint form is available in hard copy at the offices of the Phillipsburg City Clerk. Upon request, the City of Phillipsburg will mail the complaint form. **Such complaints must be filed within 180 calendar days after the date the discrimination occurred.**

Notes: Assistance in the preparation of any complaints will be provided to a person or persons upon request and as appropriate. If information is needed in another language, then contact the Phillipsburg City Clerk at 785-543-5234. (See 1 in footnote below.)

2. Referral to Review Officer

Upon receipt of the complaint, the City Clerk will notify the Phillipsburg City Council who shall appoint one or more staff review officers, as appropriate, to evaluate and investigate the complaint. If necessary, the Complainant shall meet with the staff review officer(s) to further explain his or her complaint. The staff review officer(s) shall complete their review no later than 45 calendar days after the date the agency received the complaint. If more time is required, the Phillipsburg City Council shall notify the Complainant of the estimated timeframe for completing the review. Upon completion of the review, the staff review officer(s) shall make a recommendation regarding the merit of the complaint and whether remedial actions are available to provide redress. Additionally, the staff review officer(s)

may recommend improvements to City of Phillipsburg processes relative to Title VI, as appropriate. The staff review officer(s) shall forward their recommendations to the Phillipsburg City Attorney for concurrence. If the City Attorney concurs, he or she shall issue the City of Phillipsburg's written response to the Complainant. This final report should include a summary of the investigation, all findings with recommendations, and corrective measures where appropriate.

Note: Upon receipt of a complaint, the City of Phillipsburg shall forward a copy of this complaint and the resulting written response to the appropriate KDOT and FTA-Region 7 contacts.

3. Request for Reconsideration

If the Complainant disagrees with the City Attorney's response, he or she may request reconsideration by submitting the request, in writing, to the City Attorney within 10 calendar days after receipt of the City Attorney's response. The request for reconsideration shall be sufficiently detailed to contain any items the Complainant feels were not fully understood by the City Attorney. The City Attorney will notify the Complainant of his or her decision in writing either to accept or reject the request for reconsideration within 10 calendar days. In cases where the City Attorney agrees to reconsider, the matter shall be returned to the staff review officer(s) to re-evaluate in accordance with Paragraph 2 above.

4. Appeal

If the request for reconsideration is denied, the Complainant may appeal the City Attorney's response by submitting a written appeal to the Phillipsburg City Council no later than 10 calendar days after receipt of the City Attorney's written decision rejecting reconsideration. The Phillipsburg City Council will then make a determination to either request re-evaluation by the staff review officer(s) or forward the complaint to KDOT for further investigation.

5. Submission of Complaint to the State of Kansas Department of Transportation.

If the Complainant is dissatisfied with City of Phillipsburg's resolution of the complaint, he or she may also submit a written complaint within 180 days after the alleged date of discrimination to the State of Kansas Department of Transportation for further investigation.
