ORDINANCE NO. 1390

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7-407 (b) OF ORDINANCE 1384 OF THE CITY OF PHILLIPBURG, KANSAS, WHICH PERTAINS TO DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG ON PRIVATE PROPERTY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF PHILLIPSBURG, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Section 7-407 (b) of Ordinance 1384 of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7-407 (b) DISCHARGE ON PRIVATE PROPERTY REGULATION. It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge, ignite or fire any fireworks upon any private property within the city from 10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.; except, that on July 4 of each year, fireworks may be discharged, ignited or fired upon private property within the city from 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 a.m. midnight.


Any person violating any provision of this section shall be punished as provided in Section 1-1116 of Ordinance 1384.

Section 2. That Section 7-407 (b) of Ordinance 1384 of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas, as originally written and approved on November 18, 2013, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the official newspaper of the City of Phillipsburg, Kansas.
